



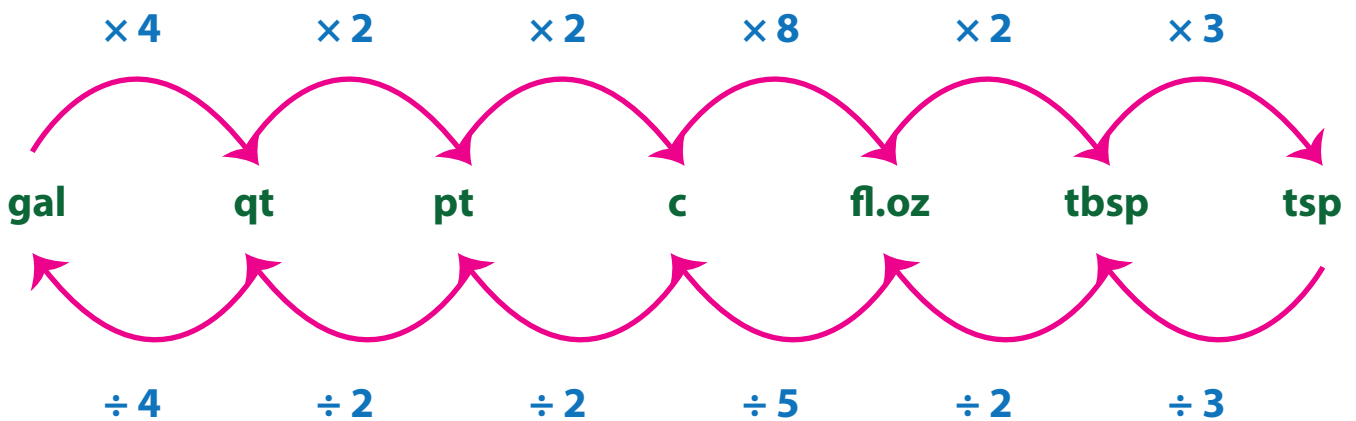

Converting larger units to smaller units

$$1 \text{ gal} = 4 \text{ qt}$$

$$1 \text{ qt} = 2 \text{ pt}$$

$$1 \text{ pt} = 2 \text{ c}$$

$$1 \text{ c} = 8 \text{ fl.oz}$$

$$1 \text{ fl.oz} = 2 \text{ tbsp}$$

$$1 \text{ tbsp} = 3 \text{ tsp}$$

Converting smaller units to larger units

$$1 \text{ qt} = \frac{1}{4} \text{ gal}$$

$$1 \text{ pt} = \frac{1}{2} \text{ qt}$$

$$1 \text{ c} = \frac{1}{2} \text{ pt}$$

$$1 \text{ fl.oz} = \frac{1}{8} \text{ c}$$

$$1 \text{ tbsp} = \frac{1}{2} \text{ fl.oz}$$

$$1 \text{ tsp} = \frac{1}{3} \text{ tbsp}$$
