Example : Convert 7 c to tbsp.

$$\begin{aligned}7 \text{ c} &= 7 \times 8 \\ &= 56 \text{ fl.oz} \\ &= 56 \times 2 \\ &= \mathbf{112 \text{ tbsp}}\end{aligned}$$

1 fluid ounce (fl.oz) = 2 tablespoons (tbsp)
1 cup (c) = 8 fluid ounces (fl.oz)
1 pint (pt) = 2 cups (c)
